Monthly update

- ✓ Met with Wyoming Game and Fish Department to discuss the goals and objectives for the Jelm WHMA project and the Hart Ranch project. Both projects will include some stream work within the Laramie River. The focus for the meeting was to agree as partners on what will be required in a Request for Proposal in our search for engineering services.
- ✓ Project Tour: Holly Kennedy (WACD) reached out to LRCD ask if we would be willing to show two of Senator Lummis's aides some of projects the district has been working on. We elected to present two full stream diversions and began with a visit to the Oasis Diversion on the Laramie River (before construction) north of Laramie and then traveled to the Dowlin Diversion on the Laramie River (after construction) west of Laramie.

- Continued to provide technical assistance to a landowner for routing a new livestock watering pipeline
- Toured pepper weed project with Lindsey (ACWP). Contractors were working south of Hwy 34 and east of Hwy 30. Also looking at what was treated last year, Lindsey was happy with the results.
